

Checklist

Please ensure that you bring all of these items when you drop your dog off for training.
If it's not on the list we won't need it. We have plenty of bowls, food measures and crates.

Required PRIOR to Drop off	Required Items to Bring
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Fecal test for parasites, including giardia <u>within 14</u> days of arrival. Get results and include with the Medical Form</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Complete Medical Form, email or FB the form & corresponding documents <u>5 days prior</u> to your dog's arrival</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Your dog is clean, well groomed, nails cut, hair around eyes trimmed short enough for unobstructed vision of it's handler at their side. Poodles and Doodles must be in a short clip</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Pay the PayPal invoice for equipment charge, will be emailed a few days prior to arrival date</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Your balance is due when you drop your dog off-cash or check only</p> <hr style="border: 1px solid black;"/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Optional Items to Bring</u></p> <hr style="border: 1px solid black;"/> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Any Bedding - only if your dog is accustomed to bedding and does not chew on it. Bedding must be clean, odor free, no rips or tears and easily washable.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Toys- only if your dog enjoys and is accustomed to them in the crate, limit of 3, clean, without rips or tears, washable, and please, for the sake of our sanity, no squeaky toys</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Regular Flat Collar or Martingale (No choke chains or body harnesses)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Identification tag or plate attached to the flat collar, that includes the dog's name and a phone number.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Leash between three and six feet in length. (No Chain Leashes or Retractable Leashes)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Food enough for your dog's stay. (It is a good idea to pack a little bit extra food, just in case)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Chew- hard chews relieve stress, good choices: Benebone, Nylabone, deer antler-no rawhide. For safety, toys and chews must be longer than the dog's lower jaw.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> At least 24 oz of <u>small, soft training</u> treats your dog likes. It will say "Training Treats" on the bag if it's the right size. (Not regular size treats, not crunchy treats). This is important to your dog's training. These are used for training and we use a lot of them! It is necessary that they are small, soft and that your dog really likes them! Most dogs like BiJac Little Jacs and the Little Jacs are just the perfect size)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Any medications must be in a labeled prescription bottle. Provide corresponding vet records with Medical Form</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Prong and e collar if we've previously introduced them to your dog</p> <p><u>Aggression Rehab Program:</u> <input type="checkbox"/> appropriate size basket muzzle</p>
